

I Didn't Want to Bother You.

IS GOD TOO BUSY TO BE BURDEREND WITH OUR PRAYERS? ISAIAH 43:22-24

Again we exhort the believer, guard against the least declension in prayer; ... go to the Lord in your worst frames; ... The gospel says, – "go in your very worst frames"; Christ says, – "come just as you are": and every promise in every example but encourages the soul to repair to the cross whatever be its frame or condition. Octavius Winslow

> ... However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?" Luke 18:8

God has a lot on His plate. He sovereignly keeps track of every atom in the universe. He does this every second of every minute of every hour of every day, and God does not sleep (Psalm 121:4). Because of this, sometimes we may begin to think that our concerns are small potatoes to God. After all, does God really have time to hear our prayers? After all, we don't want to bother Him!

Please open your Bibles to Isaiah 43:22–24. In these three verses, the Lord responds to a very similar sentiment in the people of Israel. They had begun to think that the worship of God was actually a burden to God. They had fallen into the mindset that maybe God was too busy to hear their prayers and accept their praise, and maybe they were actually getting on His nerves.

Isaiah 43:22—I haven't become weary of you. You have become weary of me.

The reluctance on the part of Israel to pray was not due to any supposed pious concern for God's time. God sees right through their anemic attempts at justifying their disobedience by expressing it in religious terms. God responds with heart-wrenching clarity: Israel, I'm not too busy for you. You have become too busy for Me!

How about you? Do you say things like, "Oh, I'm sure the Lord has more important things on His mind than to hear my paltry prayers! I don't want to bother Him." That is not an issue. He is more than willing to hear you. The question is whether you will be faithful to lift your prayers to Him.

Isaiah 43:23—I haven't burdened you with worship, yet you have become weary of me.

Let's face it, sometimes serving the Lord is exhausting. Sometimes it takes all that we have on a Sunday morning to drag ourselves out of bed and get ready for church. We can sometimes get weary with church life, but not because God asks too much of us. We are weary because we have asked too little of Him and have accepted too much from the world.

How does God respond to our spiritual sluggishness? By reminding us that the worship of the Lord is not our burden, it is our blessing. In 1 John 5:3 we are told, "For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome." Do you see this? We love God when we obey Him and it is NOT a burden. Do you really delight in the things of God, or are they a burden to you?

Isaiah 43:24—I have been burdened with your sins; You have wearied me with your iniquities.

If we are honest with ourselves, we know what really weighs us down in this life. It's not only our schedules, although we often over commit. It's not our relationships, although people can be a little difficult sometimes. What really weighs us down in this life is our sins. The good news, though, is that God is always ready and able to hear us when we come to Him in sincere repentance. Not only that, but He wants to hear from us. For some reason that baffles our minds, we are not a burden to the Lord. No. We are a blessing to the Lord.

To please God... To be a real ingredient in the divine happiness... To be loved by God, not merely pitied, but delighted in as an artist delights in his work or a father in a son—it seems impossible, a weight or burden of glory which our thoughts can hardly sustain. But so it is. C. S. Lewis

Mrecept Bible Study

The Bible was written so that anyone who wants to learn who God is and how they can live in a way that pleases Him can read it and find out. As we grow in our walk with Christ, our desire to dig deeper into His Word becomes our focus. It begins as curiosity and turns into a hunger for knowledge and application to our daily lives. In her book How to Study Your Bible, Kay Arthur said, "If you long to know God, if you want to live the Christian life faithfully and know what God requires of you, you must do more than merely read the Bible and study what someone else says about it." Calvary Bible Church is blessed with many fantastic opportunities to study God's word. *Precept Upon Precept* is one of those ways.

Precept uses a method called inductive study. It does not teach you what the Bible means or what to believe; rather, it uses the Bible itself as the primary source of information. Commentaries and video lessons are consulted only after we have made our own thorough examination of the Scriptures with guidance and insight from the Holy Spirit.

On September 24, we will begin a study of the book of The Revelation which is Christ's message to the church. Christ said in Revelation 1:3, "Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy aloud, and blessed are those who hear and obey the things written in it." This first study on the book of The Revelation requires 10 lessons to cover the first three chapters. This gives you an idea of the depth of this study. Each lesson includes five days of homework after which we gather in a group session to discuss what we learned.

There are two class sessions each Tuesday that cover the same lesson for that week. You may choose which to attend each week within the constructs of your schedule. The first class is at 10:00 AM and the second class is at 6:30 PM in room 201 via entrance F.
