Books that Can Teach Me to Pray:

AN ANNOTATED BIBLIOGRAPHY ON PRAYER

A good book is the precious life-blood of a master spirit, embalmed and treasured up on purpose to a life beyond life.

Here are some books that I would recommend on the topic of prayer with some notes and comments on each one. I also wanted to note that, when possible, I have included how much these books cost at the Cumberland Valley Bible Bookstore in Carlisle. This bookstore is local, independent, and often offers prices that can't be beat.

1. A Call to Prayer by J. C. Ryle

This little booklet is one of the very best things on prayer that I have ever read. It is clear, direct, and convicting. Ryle's main question in this book is simply, "Do you pray?" He seeks to convince us that prayer is not of secondary importance, but instead a primary demonstration of our standing before God. It's phenomenal.

2. Prayer by John Bunyan [\$6 on www.cvbbs.com]

Of all the books written about prayer, none are better than John Bunyan's classic on prayer. After all, what else would we expect from the author of *Pilgrim's Progress*? It is longer and more detailed than Ryle's booklet, and where Ryle might be more directly convicting, this book is probably more practically helpful. At only \$6 per copy, this book is worth its weight in gold.

3. Valley of Vision edited by Arthur Bennett [available in softcover or even leather binding at www.cvbbs.com]

There are many books on prayer that you take off of a bookshelf, read and then return. This book is not one of them. Arthur Bennett's *Valley of Vision* is a book that I keep with me constantly. Where I go, most of the time, this book is with me. *Valley of Vision* is a collection of Puritan Prayers and

devotions, and there is gold on every page. This book is theologically robust while at the same time practical and easy to read. There is a little bit of archaic language ("thees and "thous), but you get used to that pretty quickly. All of the books listed in this bibliography have changed my prayers. This book changed my life, and it still does in every subsequent reading.

4. Piercing Heaven/ Grace from Heaven/ Fount of Heaven by Robert Elmer [\$56.23 for all three on wtsbooks.com]

This book is a bit of a knock off of the Valley of Vision. However, what these books offer is content that is nearly as beautiful as the Valley of Vision, but with 3 volumes, there is just much more of it. In these very attractive volumes, Robert Elmer gives us a collection of prayers that span the centuries. They are also available individually, but why just get one?

5. A Way to Pray by Matthew Henry [\$21.25 on www.cvbbs.com]

Matthew Henry is known for his commentary on the whole Bible. That is his magnum opus. However, I think that this book may actually be more helpful. It is practical, powerful and will give you a lot of strategic specificity in your quest to learn how to pray more effectively.

6. A Guide to Prayer by Isaac Watts [\$14.25 on www.cvbbs.com]

Very similar to Matthew Henry's book is that of Isaac Watts. Watts is the author of many famous hymns, and he brings that air of worship to his prayer book. This book is just as helpful (and quite a bit shorter) than Henry's book. I have been very blessed in reading it.

7. The Pastor in Prayer by Charles Spurgeon [\$12.75 on www.cvbbs.com]

Prayer is often easier caught than taught. We benefit from examples in prayer. In this marvelous little book, some of the public prayers of the great Charles Spurgeon are recorded for us, and it is just a delight to read these.

8. Letters to Malcolm: Chiefly on Prayer by C.S. Lewis [\$10.49 on www.cvbbs.com]

The pastoral team have been getting together twice a month to discuss this book, and I have really enjoyed it. In this book, C.S. Lewis writes letters to a fictional person named Malcolm, and in doing, shares his thoughts on prayer. It is not only really spiritually helpful, but it is also downright entertaining! I recommend it highly.

There are so many more books on prayer, but our space is limited. If none of these strike your fancy, please feel free to reach out to me for more recommendations.
